At Al-Abraar Academy, the safety and well-being of our students and the surrounding community is our top priority. To ensure a smooth and secure drop-off and pick-up process for parents and guardians, we have established this parking policy. This policy aims to maintain a safe environment for everyone while minimising traffic congestion and disruptions in the busy residential area. We kindly request the cooperation of all parents and guardians in adhering to these guidelines.

Operating Hours: Drop-off and pick-up times will be coordinated with the schedule at Al Abraar Academy and Masjid Adam, ensuring minimal disruption to the neighbourhood. The specific times are as follows:

Drop off: 9:00am

Pick-up: 12:00pm

Traffic Speed Limit: The traffic speed limit in the vicinity of Al Abraar Academy is 30mph, and we expect all parents and guardians to comply with this limit for the safety of our students and residents.

Parking Guidelines:

- 1. We kindly request that all parents and guardians be considerate of the residential community surrounding our school. Avoid blocking driveways, respect parking restrictions, and be mindful of noise levels.
- 2. Parents and guardians are requested to refrain from parking or dropping off/picking up along Seven Kings Road. Instead, we encourage parents to utilise the nearby roads for parking and personally escort their children to and from the Academy for drop-off and pickup.
- 3. We encourage all parents and guardians to adhere to a strict no-idling policy to reduce air pollution and promote a healthier environment for the community.
- 4. To maintain a smooth traffic flow and minimise congestion, please follow the indicated direction of traffic in the nearby roads.
- 5. Non-compliance with this parking policy may result in seriously endangering lives and causing harm, especially of young children and the elderly.
- 6. Not adhering to this policy will lead to your child's suspension for a minimum of two weeks. Persistent non-compliance may result in your child's dismissal from the evening madrasah.
