Uniform and Hygiene Policy

As part of our commitment to fostering a sense of unity, pride, and focus among our students, we have established a comprehensive Uniform and Hygiene Policy. This policy reflects our dedication to maintaining a standard of dress and personal cleanliness that aligns with the values of Al Abraar Academy. By adhering to these guidelines, we believe our students will not only project a positive image but will also be better positioned to concentrate on their academic pursuits without unnecessary distractions. This policy serves as a cornerstone in our mission to cultivate a culture of respect, responsibility, and academic excellence at Al Abraar Academy.

Dress Code for Boys:

- Plain white jubba/thobe or shalwar qamees
- Plain white cap (topi)
- Trousers/Shalwar must not extend below the ankles
- Undergarments must not visible
- For safety reasons, wearing of jewellery items such as chains, necklaces, rings, and earrings is strictly prohibited.

Dress Code for Girls:

- Full-length, plain black, loose-fitting abaya/jilbaab
- Plain black scarf/burka, which covers the shoulders
- Hair should be neatly combed, tied, and tucked in, ensuring it remains covered at all times
- Pins with a sharp needle end should be avoided, for safety reasons
- For safety reasons, wearing of jewellery items such as chains, necklaces, rings, and earrings is strictly prohibited
- The use of makeup or any form of nail varnish is not permitted under any circumstances

Promoting Uniform And Hygiene Compliance

- 1. Al Abraar Academy reserves the right to send any student home if found in incorrect uniform attire.
- 2. It is imperative for both parents and students to actively ensure adherence to the Uniform and Hygiene Policy, guaranteeing that students are appropriately dressed.
- 3. Repeated violations of the Uniform and Hygiene Policy may lead to suspension or meetings with the Head Teacher.
- 4. Students will not be readmitted to Al Abraar Academy until corrective measures are taken by both the student and the parent. Failure to comply may result in further disciplinary actions, including expulsion.
- 5. Students are expected to maintain personal hygiene by dressing in a neat manner, washing their face, brushing their teeth, before attending Al Abraar Academy
- 6. Regular nail cutting is encouraged to prevent the accumulation of dirt.
- 7. Parents are responsible for ensuring that each child wears clean socks daily.
- 8. Parents are reminded to ensure that children use the toilet and perform wudhu (ablution) at home before coming to Al Abraar Academy.
